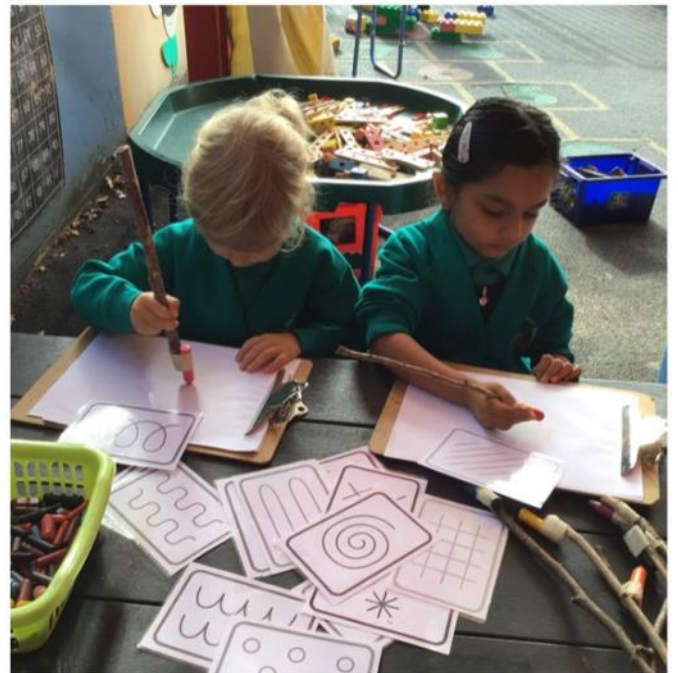

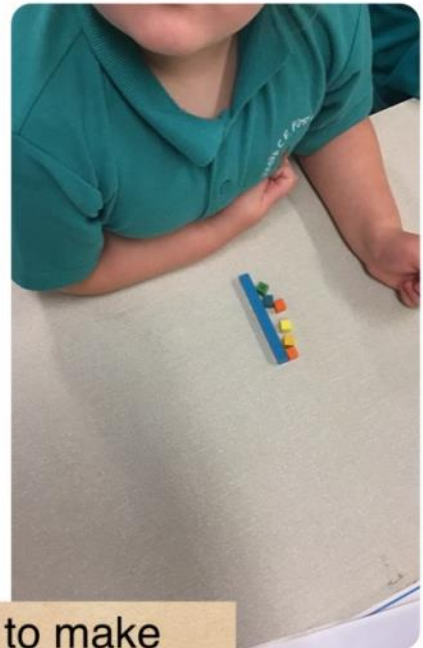

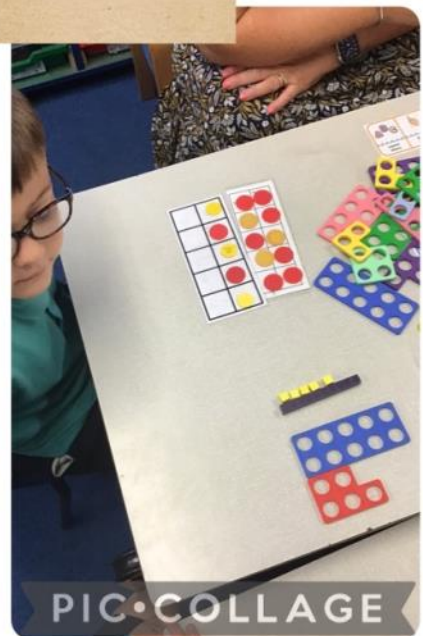


Yellow class had a fantastic first day back to school!





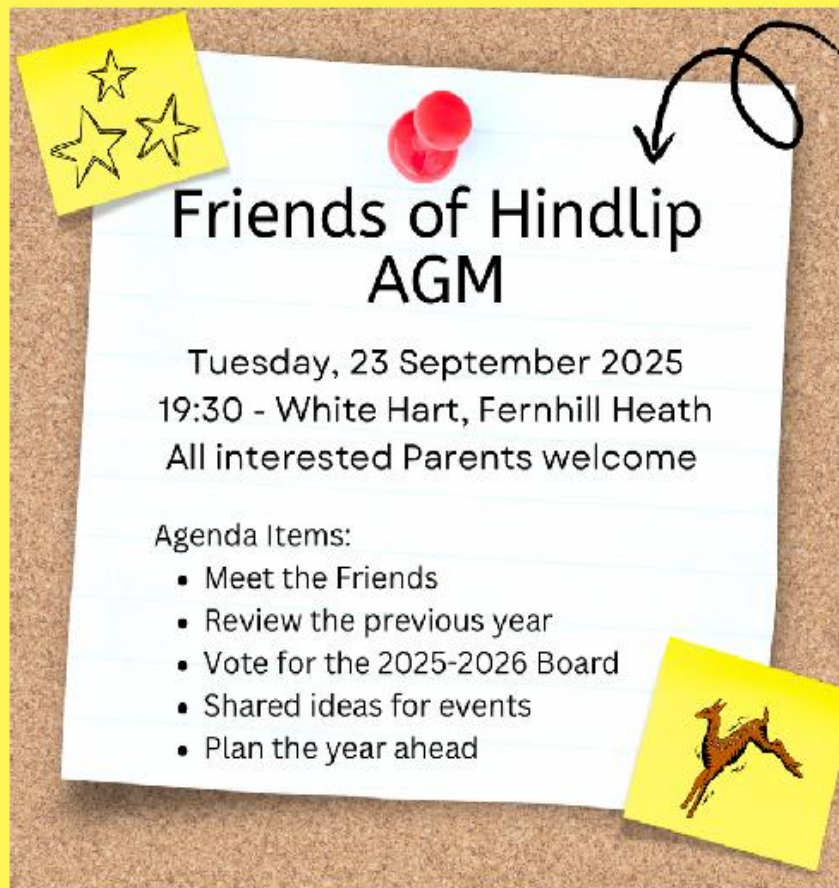
Yellow class using math resources to make numbers to 20.
