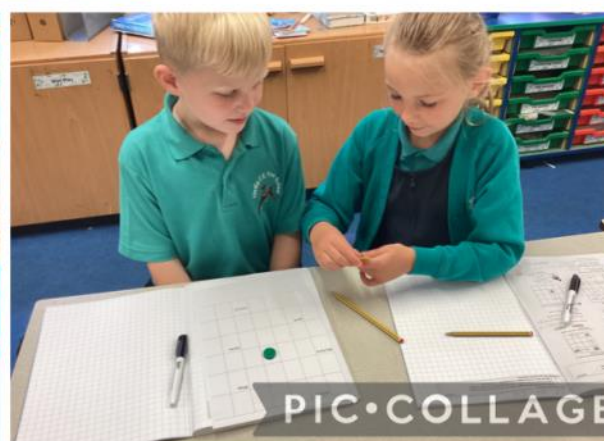
In Art this week Blue Class created their own fabric prints using seashells.

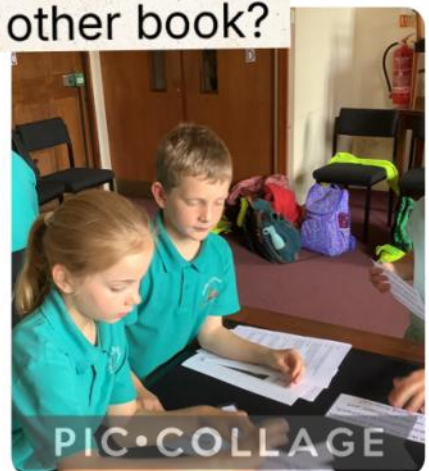
