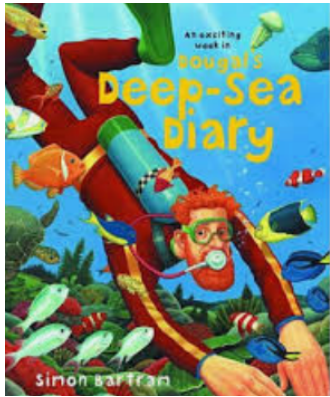


In English we will be looking at the stories Dougal the deep sea diver and The Pirates next door

Why is Dame Ellen MacArthur a dame?

Timeline of sea exploration

Marco Polo (1254-1324)

Marco was one of the first people to travel from Europe to China in 1271.

Christopher Columbus (1451-1506)

Christopher sailed west from Europe to the Americas in 1492.

Sir Walter Raleigh (1552-1618)

Walter sailed to America and tried to set up a colony there in 1578.

Captain James Cook (1728-1779)

James went on many voyages before he was killed in Hawaii in 1776.

Dame Ellen MacArthur (1976-present)

Ellen set a new world record in 2005 by solo sailing around the world in 71 days.

Vocabulary

explorer	A person who travels to places where no one has been before to see what is there.
navigator	A person who uses maps or special instruments to plan and direct the route of a ship, aircraft or other form of transport.
century	A period of 100 years.
decade	A period of 10 years.
timeline	A list of events in the time they happened.

In Science we will be looking at animals including humans.

- that humans have offspring which grow into adults
- the importance for humans of exercise,
- eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.
