We will be listening to the story of Jim and the beanstalk and measuring different parts of our body!

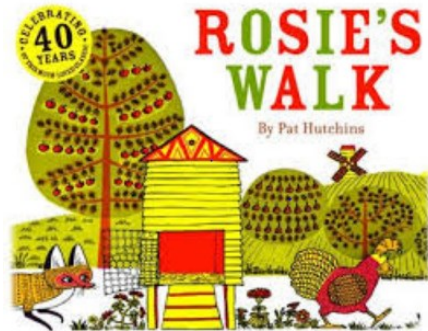


This is Beebot!
