

Nursery rhymes.

In this topic, we will be learning different nursery rhymes and taking part in themed activities. We will also be performing!

Key vocabulary:

Literacy- phoneme; digraph; trigraph; rhyming word

Maths- subitise; number bonds; 3D shape names (cone; sphere; cube; cuboid; cylinder); O'clock.

We will be making paper plate clocks, practising how to write our numbers and learning how to tell the time (on the hour only!!)

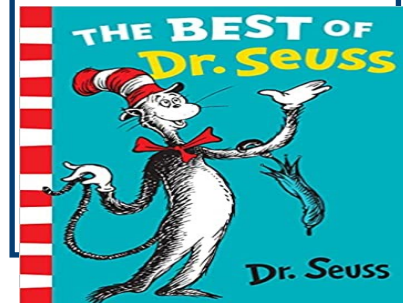


Polly put the kettle on
