CHRISTMAS PERFORMANCE - 13th DECEMBER 2023 2.15pm to 3.15pm

Our Christmas performance is approaching and we are busy putting together the plan for this lovely celebration of the Christmas story.

The children will need to wear a Christmas jumper and a Santa hat. They will need additional layers under their jumpers so that we can avoid them wearing their coats if possible. If the weather looks unsuitable for this, we will of course allow coats to be worn.

The children will all be involved in singing and performing the Christmas story, with Orange Class reading the narrative and taking on the roles of the main characters. These costumes will be provided by school and Mrs Herbert will be in contact with Year 3 and 4 parents if they are required to have a different item of clothing to go under their costumes. We will be putting out very limited seating using our school benches but if you require a different seat (e.g. with a back/camping chair) you may wish to bring it with you.

Parents will need to enter the playground via the gates in Sling Lane. Children will be seated in their classes and will need to stay with their class throughout the performance. Once the performance has finished, teachers will take the children back to their class to collect their belongings and then dismiss as normal. We are really looking forward to hearing the children perform and although it is different to previous years, we know that it will be a truly special Christmas event, that will definitely be one to look back on fondly.
